Safe Guarding Information for Parents/Guardians of those participating in The Pope John Paul II Award

All those under 18 participating in the Award must have parental consent.

Award participants will volunteer in their local parish and Church. The parish will ensure there is adequate supervision and a safe environment for participants to meet and take part in ministries such as choir, reading and cleaning the Church.

If trips are organised by the parish, the parish will inform you of the specific details and needs and provide supervision.

Participants may take part in parish and social activities through school. The school will ensure adequate supervision and safety for these activities.

Participants may also volunteer with organisations and charities such as Trocaire, SVP, GAA, Children in Crossfire, etc. These organisations will be responsible for supervision. By agreeing to let your son/daughter volunteer with them, you are entrusting their safety to the specific organisation/charity.

Participants under 18 do not need to be vetted or have reference checks to work with younger children or vulnerable adults. They do however, need to be supervised at all times by an adult over 18 years who has successfully gone through the vetting procedures.

Award leaders in schools and parishes must be vetted and work in accordance with the Code of Conduct for working with young people.

Participants must act in accordance with the Code of Conduct for young adults.

Photographs may be taken from time to time of activities or trips and used for promoting the Pope John Paul II Award only. (Photographs relating to the activities of the Pope John Paul II Award may not be posted on social networking sites without the permission of the leader).

Participants will be asked to provide an email and mobile number for communication. These details will only be used by the leaders for the purpose of the Pope John Paul II Award activities. From time to time reminder texts or emails may be sent to the participant from the parish to help organise an event or activity. The participants contact details will be deleted when the Award has been completed.
